

Year 2 Spring Term

English:

This term we will be writing for a range of purposes including poetry and postcards using the books Grandad's Camper and If the World was a Stage.

Maths:

This term in Maths the children will be working to continue their understanding of shape, Multiplication, division and measure.

History:

This term our History unit focuses on women who have changed the world. A large proportion of this will be spent studying the contributions of Amelia Earhart and Rosa Parks.

RE:

The children will explore the concept of leadership within the Jewish faith; focusing on Moses. We will then be exploring why Easter is so important to Christians.

Reading:

In class the children are currently reading Paddington by Michael Bond and will move on to Roald Dahl's Fantastic Mr Fox. The children will also engage in 1 VIPERS session a week; learning key comprehension skills.

Geography:

This term, we will be exploring where we are on the Globe by looking at the continents and oceans and what it is like in some of these.

PSHE:

In Year 2 this term we will be focusing on citizenship.

Music:

We will be exploring timbre and pitch in different orchestral instruments.

Art:

We will explore colour and how it can represent our individuality.

Science:

This term, our Science unit explores Animals including Humans. In the first half of term, we will explore life cycles and how animals and humans change over time and then we will move on to hygiene and the importance of exercise.

Computing:

In the first half term we will become excellent word processors before moving on to block coding after half term.

In the PE we will be developing our skills in gymnastics, football, yoga and other ball games.
