

Year 1 Summer Curriculum map 2025-26

English:

This term, we will be writing for a range of purposes including letters, captions, character descriptions, speech bubbles, narratives, instructions and a pamphlet using the books Lost and Found, Beegu, Stanley's Stick and Dinosaurs and all that Rubbish.

Maths:

This term, we will be focusing on multiplication and division and numbers within 100. We will also be exploring fractions, money, time and position and direction.

Science:

We will be identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. We will also be describing the structure of different plants.

Phonics and Reading:

We will continue to develop our phonic knowledge within phase 5. This will help us with our decoding during reading sessions and with our segmenting for spelling. We will also be developing speed and expression to support our comprehension.

History:

We will be learning about British Queens. We will be finding out about the lives and achievements of Queen Elizabeth II, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth I.

Geography:

We will be finding out about the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and the surrounding seas.

Computing:

We will be exploring programming and digital imagery. We will also be learning about data and how it can be gathered and recorded.

Music:

We will be learning about musical symbols and pitch and we will be composing simple tunes.

PE:

We will be developing our skills in tennis, athletics and cricket. We will also be taking part in problem-solving and teamwork challenges.

RE:

We will be looking at different stories from the Bible and we will be finding out how and why Shabbat is important for Jewish people living in Britain.

PSHE:

We will be learning about citizenship and economic wellbeing.

DT:

We will be learning about fruit and we will be making and evaluating fruit smoothies.

Art:

We will be learning about primary and secondary colours and colour mixing techniques.
